2026 Chapman Memorial Piano Competition Tuesday, March 10, 2026

REQUIREMENTS

Competitor must be a resident of **Waukesha County**. Competitor must be at least 14 years of age but not more than 20 years old by March 1, 2026. All contestants must provide the judges with three copies of the concerto being performed.

Competitor must choose one selection from the following repertoire to perform from memory:

- Beethoven** – Piano Concerto No. 1, first movement
- Beethoven** – Piano Concerto No. 3, last movement
- Beethoven** – Piano Concerto No. 4, first or last movements
- Beethoven** – Piano Concerto No. 5, first or second AND third movement
- Fauré** – Ballade
- Franck** – Symphonic Variations
- Grieg** – Piano Concerto in A Minor, first movement
- Mozart** – Piano Concerto No. 20 in D Minor, last movement
- Mozart** – Piano Concerto No. 21 (“Elvira Madigan”), last movement
- Mendelssohn** – Piano Concerto No. 1 in G Minor, first or third movement
- Saint-Saens** – Piano Concerto No. 3 in E-flat Major, first movement

Note: An accompanist is required. A second piano will be available for your accompanist.

You will be notified of your audition time by March 8, 2026. Auditions are closed to the public.

PRIZE

The winner will appear as soloist with the Wisconsin Philharmonic in the 2026-2027 season and will receive a cash award of \$800. The winner and his/her accompanist will also be required to perform at the Shining Stars Recital on Tuesday, April 14, 2026 at 6:30 p.m. The decision of the judges is final. The Wisconsin Philharmonic reserves the right not to award the prize should a qualified winner not emerge during the competition.
